# Rules

Cancellation Policy: Due to the advanced purchase of prizes leading up to the hunt, no refunds or credit towards next year`s hunt will be offered 5 days prior to hunt day.

1. Only registered persons may participate.
2. Registrants entering the hunts without proper hunt badge, or no hunt badge, will be disqualified without refund.
3. No one will be permitted in the hunt area during the hunts without a detector, head phones and hunt badge.
4. No PULSE detectors allowed.
5. Side baskets are allowed.
6. Anyone not following responsible metal detecting practice, such as not filling holes, will be disqualified without a refund.
7. Coils are limited to 12" maximum largest dimension.
8. This event is RAIN or SHINE (no rain date). Please bring proper clothing for the weather.
9. If you have to cancel 5 days prior to the hunt, you'll get a credit towards next year's open hunt. No cash refunds due to the advance purchase of prizes.
10. All targets are no more than 4 or 5 inches deep.
11. The Hunt Master`s decisions are final.
12. The Sandy Point State Park entrance fee is \$5.00 per person, subject to change. Participating in this treasure hunt is not a waiver to this entrance fee.

Turn left onto Oceanic Dr. From Eastern Shore: Follow 50/301 across Bay Bridge. Continue onto US-50 W/ Ocean Gateway. Take ramp onto US-301S. Take exit 32 for Oceanic Drive. Keep right at fork to continue towards Oceanic Dr. Turn left onto Oceanic Drive.
